The last couple months have brought both blessings and challenges. We rejoice in the blessings and face the challenges through the strength of the Lord and your help. We want you to know that we praise God for you and want to thank-you for your interest and support in our lives and work.

Our main church work, Iglesia Bautista Biblica La Luz is doing well. We are focused on training leaders and continuing to teach them to disciple other Believers. We are asking the Lord to provide a Bolivian Pastor that can lead this church. You might recall that last summer we shared with you that a young man named Gabril was saved while doing the construction work on our building. Last month, Jeff was honored to Baptize him as well as a young lady named Luciana who had recently been saved in our services.

However, we do have a challenge facing us with this work. Last year, the owner of our location indicated he'd like us to remain on the property we are using for three years. However, earlier this month he indicated that he wanted to change his plans and build an apartment building where our church now stands. Fortunately, we built an aluminum building so that it can be disassembled and moved to a new location in anticipation of purchasing our own lot. However, rather than three years, we now have a one year window in which to locate a new place in which to relocate. Please pray for this church as it continues to march forward.

Over the last year, we have been involved in starting 4 new Children's Clubs which are an ideal way to open a door to a new community. Each one is doing well and the children are becoming very faithful in their participation. Recently, at the first Club that was started, a lady named Francisca was saved. She brought her family to church and her husband, Nelson, also called on Christ to save him. They have recently offered to host the children's club that meets in their community in their home. Please pray for these new Believers. We would like to communicate with anyone who might be interested in sponsoring or partnering with one of the clubs as an outreach or partner of their Children's Ministry.



The new work that was established in October among the people living in the Santiago community has flourished, and services are being held several times throughout the week. We have outgrown the room we are currently meeting in and need to find a more suitable location. Our partner in this work, Pastor Mario Flores, has faced many health challenges. We are pleased to report that he is feeling well and is very committed to the work that God has called he and his family to. Please keep them in prayer.

We have some exciting things ahead in coming months including a Ladies Tea, a Conference in the city of Cochabamba, and work in the Bible Institute. Sandra is particularly excited about the Tea as this is a "first" for our ladies. We would like to invite anyone who might be interested in connecting with our ladies ministries to communicate with us. We believe it will be a blessing both here and among the ladies of your church.

We will share more information about the work here in Bolivia in the coming weeks. However, we ask you to connect with us online and continue to keep our work in prayer. In the meantime, here are some prayer requests we ask you to remember.

1. That Iglesia La Luz is able to call a Pastor within the next year as well as a new location to move to. Lock, stock, and building in tow!
2. That we find a suitable meeting place for the Church in Santiago.
3. Before leaving the states earlier this year, Sandra had 2 additional doctor's appointments and learned she needs to have corrective surgery from a previous operation. Though it is a rather major surgery, it is not urgent, so it will be done when we return at the end of the year for her cancer check-ups. Please keep her in your prayers.
4. Please pray for a few of our family members that reside in the states.
5. Please keep our upcoming special meetings in mind as you pray.
6. We need more workers as the works continue to grow.

We are grateful to be able to be your hands and feet here in Bolivia.
